I will recognize the benefit of positive comments as a motivational tool.</p> <p>I will not use foul language.</p> <p>I will demand an environment for my child that is free from drugs, tobacco and alcohol and I will refrain from their use at all events.</p> <p>During a rehearsal or gig, I will show common courtesy and respect for the musicians by only using a cell phone if it is an emergency.</p>	<p>I will do my best to provide a safe environment for all musicians and volunteers.</p> <p>I will lead by example in demonstrating respectable behavior.</p> <p>I will encourage respect and courteousness from musicians, crew, and volunteers at every gig, concert and rehearsal, by demonstrating positive values I hope to see in others.</p> <p>I will do my best to organize rehearsals that are fun and challenging for all musicians.</p> <p>I will not use foul language.</p> <p>I will not use drugs, tobacco and alcohol and I will refrain from their use at all events.</p> <p>I will not use a cell phone during rehearsal or gigs. If I bring my cell phone to a rehearsal, I will keep it on silent mode to be used in case of an emergency. If I bring my cell phone to a gig, I will keep it stored away. The use of electronic devices is allowed during breaks as long as use complies with the CCPS Electronic Portable Devices Guidelines. *Exceptions to this policy will be made at the directors discretion if it is determined that use of a cell phone will enhance specific performance or teaching needs.</p>	<p>I will treat my director, musicians, spectators, crew, and volunteers with respect regardless of race, sex, creed, or abilities and I will expect to be treated accordingly.</p> <p>I will do my very best to listen and learn from my director, musicians, crew, and volunteers.</p> <p>I will remember that this group is an opportunity to learn and have fun and will work hard to perform at my highest ability.</p> <p>I will respect the facility that we rehearse or perform in by being careful not to harm an instrument that may not be mine, or damage property.</p> <p>I will not use foul language.</p> <p>I will not use drugs, tobacco and alcohol and I will refrain from their use at all events.</p> <p>I will not use a cell phone during rehearsal or gigs.
